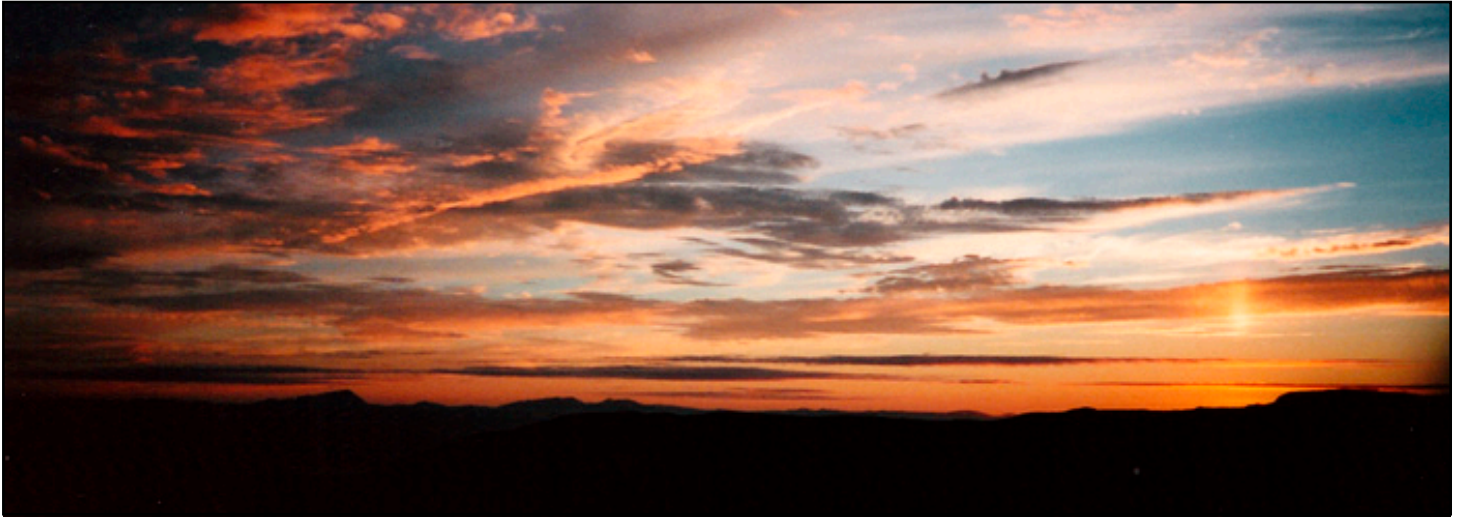


11 HALLIN PARK, WATERNISH



The Accommodation

The cottage is set in its own grounds with a gravel drive and ample space for parking. The back of the cottage faces west with views over Loch bay and the Outer Hebrides. As well as an open fire in the living room there is central heating through-out with electric radiators.

The cottage comprises of;

Lounge

A cosy, comfortably furnished room with seating for four. The open fire will take the chill off the worst that the Scottish weather can throw at you!

Sun Room

The sun room, at the rear of the cottage basks in the afternoon and evening sun. The television is situated in this room.

Kitchen

The kitchen is fully fitted and has a dining table which seats six. It also has an electric-cooker, a washing machine and a large fridge-freezer

Twin Bedroom

A ground floor bedroom with two single beds.

Double bedroom

A ground floor bedroom with a double bed.

Bathroom

A ground floor bathroom and toilet with bath and hand basin.

Directions

From Dunvegan travel along the A850 towards Edinbane. The Waternish peninsula starts at the Fairy Bridge, at which point a single track road leaves the A87. Around 6 miles from the Fairy Bridge, there is a junction where the tiny road goes over the moor to Geary and Gillen. 11 Hallin Park is situated just across the road from this junction.
